Thymic® Next controls insects, nematodes and diseases, and is safe on crops, ornamental plants and turf, when used as directed. Thymic Next contains thyme oil and directly suffocates and destroys the cell membranes of pests. Pests are not likely to develop resistance to Thymic Next due to the mode of action, making it suitable for use as part of an integrated pesticide resistance management program. Thymic Next has no re-entry or preharvest intervals and can be applied the day of harvest.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use Thymic Next to control pests any time during the season. Apply Thymic Next to the crop foliage every 7 to 10 days as necessary repeating applications to maintain the desired level of control. Apply Thymic Next in a minimum of 0.25% v/v concentration in a sufficient volume to ensure uniform and complete coverage of the treated area. Thymic Next is tank mix compatible with a range of dormant oils, fertilizers and other plant protectants. Thymic Next is safe for application in the field, greenhouse and interior spaces wherever plants are grown, when used as directed. Avoid direct contact with bees or pollinators during application. If applied during flowering period of the crop, treat during periods of low foraging activity to minimize adverse effects.

Apply to the soil for nematode prevention and control. Repeat application every 10-15 days until pressure subsides.
